- g. Natural Gas at House Perimeter

- a. This House has a 60 mil (vs std 45 mil) TPO light colored roof behind the parapets and a 26 ga. corrugated metal roof on the portals.



- b. This house has fiberglass sound insulation in all open bay interior walls between interior living spaces to minimize the transmission of sound between rooms.



- c. This house has custom kitchen cabinetry with 3/4" real wood maple veneer boxes, high end custom pullouts and details. Countertops in the kitchen are solid black granite.



d. Most houses have predominantly painted sheetrock interior walls.

This house predominantly mud plastered interior walls consisting of a custom plaster mix including Kaolin Clay, Mica, Flour, Sand, Straw and Color.



e. Exterior walls are often acrylic stucco which seals the house and does not breathe.

Exterior Walls are finished with cementitious Stucco over a cement plaster base coat providing a breathable wall system. The entire exterior is covered with expanded metal lath and then with Stucco wire to minimize cracks.



- f. The garage door is a high quality Ankmar steel wrapped door with 2" high quality insulation.



Interior Doors are custom 1 3/4" custom plank doors. Entry doors are Therma-Tru Fiberglass doors with high quality insulation values.



- g. Natural gas line has been run to the NE of house perimeter.
1" Conduit has been stubbed out to South and North sides of house for future use.
